The Faculty Grievance Appeal Committee (PTRAC) is an externally mandated board which functions pursuant to OAR 571-003-0007. The committee webpage at <http://committees.uoregon.edu/node/40> states that the function of the committee is to “hear, on request of the faculty member grieving at Step Two, all grievances excepting those concerning denial of promotion, denial of tenure (or denial of both), or failure to renew an appointment in violation of the grievant's rights.” The webpage also notes: “Since it is an appeal committee, the committee only files ‘pro-forma’ reports to the Senate every year that are not substantive in nature.”

The FGAC heard one case during the 2015-16 academic year.
