The Scholastic Review Committee meets on a regular schedule, every other week, during the academic year. The committee also holds meetings for review during summer term.

Student petitions are reviewed at each meeting. At the end of each term the committee meets for End of Term Review, (EOTR). At EOTR the records of students who were disqualified are reviewed. The committee may elect to cancel a student's disqualification if they deem the reason for disqualification to be due to extenuating circumstances.

Policy and Guideline Changes

The committee also discusses SRC policies, and periodically makes changes.

During the 2010-2011 academic year, SRC implemented a new policy for students who are approved for reinstatement and do not register for the term in which they are approved. These students must contact an advisor in the Office of Academic Advising and request a deferral to register in the subsequent term. If they do not register in the term for which they are approved or the subsequent term (fall term for students reinstated in spring), the student will be required to submit a new petition for reinstatement.

Ten-Year Review

In addition to the Committee's traditional work, this year SRC also submitted a ten-year review in March 2011 at the request of the Faculty Senate. As a result of the review, SRC suggested that the membership list and voting rights be updated in the Committee documents, but otherwise believed SRC's work to be significant and necessary.
